PRODUCT INFORMATION

Citra-Guard XP is a liquid foliar formulation designed to correct and prevent Nitrogen deficiencies in citrus and most crops. If added to the spray tank first, it will aid in lowering the water pH. A jar test to check the compatibilities of unfamiliar or new combinations should be performed prior to mixing and application. The addition of a non-ionic surfactant will aid in surface coverage which will help leaf absorption.

CROP RECOMMENDATIONS

Citrus Trees: Apply 1/2 gallon per acre through irrigation. Can be applied with herbicide for ground application or fertilizer application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Citra-Guard XP should be applied at 1 to 2 quarts per application in 100 gallons of water per acre.

Aerial application: Apply 1 quart per acre in 5 to 10 gallons of water

Citra-Guard XP will aid in lowering pH of irrigation water.

DANGER

If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call doctor. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell. Absorb spillage to prevent material damage.

Storage: Store locked up. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed. Store in corrosive resistant container (polyethylene, polypropylene - See Section 7 of SDS).

Disposal: Dispose of contents/containers in accordance with local/regional/national regulations (See Section 13 of SDS). Containers may be triple rinsed and offered for recycling.

Keep away from children. Do not drink. Do not contaminate feed, seed or water supplies. Avoid spraying on concrete surfaces as staining may occur.
