Product Information

Dyna Pro Zinc EDTA is a fully chelated solution recommended for the prevention and/or correction of zinc deficiency in all crops when used as a part of a balanced fertility program.

Application Rates

Soil Application

Dyna Pro Zinc EDTA is a concentrated solution and is recommended for use on all types of soils.

NOTE: The rates given below are based on broadcast application. Phytotoxicity may result if the broadcast rates are used for spot or banded applications.

Field, Row, Vegetable Crops: Apply 2-8 quarts per acre.

Fruit, Tree and Vine Crops: Apply 2-10 quarts per acre or 1-4 Tbsp per inch of tree diameter.

Ornamentals: Apply 2 Tbsp for small shrubs and up to 2 Tbsp per inch of tree diameter for large trees and shrubs.

Turf: Apply to only actively growing turf in the setting of professional use. Apply 4 oz per 1,000 sq. ft. or 1.5 gallons per acre.

Foliar Application

For the most desirable results, avoid the application of **Dyna Pro Zinc EDTA** when plants are suffering from moisture stress. Before general application, apply the spray solution to a small test area of the crop or foliage to assess any undesirable effects or phytotoxicity.

Field, Row, Vegetable Crops: Apply 1-2 pints per acre in at least 20 gallons of water.

Fruit, Tree and Vine Crops: Apply 1-2 pints per acre in at least 25 gallons of water. For smooth skinned fruit apply 1 pint per acre in 50-100 gallons of water.

Citrus: Apply 1-2 pints per 100 gallons of cover spray any time excepts during bloom.

Aerial: Apply 0.5-1 pint per acre in at least 10 gallons of water.

Prevention

Wear protective gloves, chemical splash proof goggles, and face protection. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.

Response

Get medical attention/advice if you feel unwell.

If on skin : Wash with plenty of water. Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical attention.

If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Call doctor or poison control.

If Swallowed: Rinse mouth, Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call physician or poison control.

Disposal: Dispose of contents/containers in accordance with local/regional/national regulations (See Section 13 of SDS). Containers may be triple rinsed and offered for recycling.

Keep away from children. Avoid breathing mists, eye contact or repeat contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not drink. Do not contaminate feed, seed or water supplies.
